Recreation Committee Meeting
April 29, 2021 @ 2:00pm. - Marble Hall/via Zoom

Call to Order, Roll Call:

The meeting of the Recreation Committee was called to order at 2:01 PM. Present were: Chairperson Ted Fischer, Tom Alferes, Anita Alferes, and Richard Pflueger. Three residents through Zoom. Excused: Mike Alexander, Sally Flagg, & Bill Fox. Also present: City Administrator, Dave Turner and Assistant City Clerk Holly Rosado.

Approval of Minutes from February 29, 2020: Motion: Made by Tom Alferes and seconded by Richard Pflueger for the approval of Minutes.

Vote: Unanimously approved

A. Limitations on use Sunset Park:

Richard Pflueger reported to the commission about allowing sunset park to stay open until one hour after sunset and for the pickleball and tennis courts to remain open until 9:00 pm. City Administrator, Dave Turner reported will check with the Commission.

B. 2021-2022 Budget Discussion:

1. Tennis – Anita Alferes – reported a new tennis net needed on street side (West) of courts. Chairperson Ted Fischer reported information will be sent to order Windscreen on S.W. Corner 50’x6’ and a new tennis net. Chairperson Ted Fischer reported consideration is needed for resurfacing the west tennis court in 2-3 years which has a projected cost of \$10,000. Becky Todd, City Clerk mentioned there is \$10,000 in reserves to use for resurfacing the courts. Chairperson Ted Fischer will get it out for bid with the verbiage of the time period it needs to be done in the fall. City Administrator, Dave Turner stated the City could provide the cost for landscaping. Anita Alferes reported the sign says opened until April 1 and would like it changed to April 30th and change the area code to 305 from 508. Anita Alferes mentioned to possibly charge people to join group tennis. Also, resurfacing court #1 and the cost is about \$10,000. Becky Todd, City Clerk mentioned there is \$10,000 in reserves to use for resurfacing the courts. Chairperson Ted Fischer will get it out for bid with the verbiage of the time period it needs to be done in the fall.
2. Golf Course –Richard Pflueger mentioned several things been done since last year. There have been several clean up and mulching days using volunteers. Two tee boxes, 4 and 7, are not fully protected and need either netting or landscaping. Richard and City Manager to meet on course to review and decide on path forward. A few of the holes need signage indicating direction to the next tee box. Darryl Rice and Mr. Turner should discuss. -. Estimated cost is \$400. Lease agreement City/Daryl Rice expired 2/19/21 with the possibility to extend it for an additional year. The cost for the contract is \$2500 a month and \$30,000 for the year. City Administrator said if Daryl Rice’s contract is up it would be up for bid – revisit City/Daryl Rice to identify Capital for improvements. Tom Alferes reported a few of the holes need signage indicating direction to the next tee box. Darryl Rice and City Administrator Dave Turner should discuss.
3. Bocce Ball: Chairperson, Ted Fischer asked if there was any record of anybody asking for money for the bocce courts Chairperson Ted Fischer mentioned Bill Fox usually takes care of bocce courts he will get with Bill Fox after the meeting to get a number for the new budget.
4. Pickleball: Ted Fischer mentioned AED need more pads and a First Aid Kit needs to be replenished in addition to items listed in last year’s budget proposal.
5. Shuffleboard: No information.

6. Basketball: Chairperson Ted Fisher stated there is one basketball that will be left in the tennis box with a sign for usage.
7. Sunset Park – City Administrator Dave Turner mentioned a grant was put in, with the help of Executive Assistant Saara Staten for new rails on the observation deck. City Administrator Dave Turner was in favor of also including a flagpole and a bicycle rack in this upgrade. The bids were opened Monday morning and he was hoping within two or three weeks get an answer on how much money.
8. Parks and Golf Course – City Administrator Dave Turner reported between all the different committees that our parks and golf course will be up to par. The better it looks, the better it is.
9. Miscellaneous – Chairperson Ted Fischer mentioned the light poles in the tennis/pickleball complex need to be painted.
10. 2020-2021 Budget - Chairpersons, Ted Fischer mentioned there was \$1,980.00 left for this year in the budget. The committee agreed to spend these funds this year to fund windscreens, tennis net, golf course netting and AED and first aid kit replenishment.
