2. Refinance of Long-Term Debt: Vice Mayor Sutton presented the available interest rate and payment schedule for Iberia Bank. Iberia Bank is offering a 10-year fixed rate of 1.93% totaling \$13,315.13 per month. The City is currently paying \$13,426 per month. The budget includes \$207,330 to pay these loans. If the Iberia rate is chosen the annual cost would be \$159,781.56.

MOTION: Motion made by Vice Mayor Sutton, seconded by Commissioner Trefry to approve consolidating the Iberia Bank and Centennial Bank into a First Horizon/Iberia Bank loan for 10 years at a fixed rate of 1.93%.

The Commission will wait until the final rate is provided by Iberia Bank to determine what will be done with the remaining funds in the budget.
