CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH CITY COMMISSION FIRST BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING

Wednesday, September 9, 2020 5:05 PM

1. **Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Roll Call:** The public hearing of the Key Colony Beach City Commission was called to order by Mayor DeNeale at 5:05 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor John DeNeale, Vice Mayor Ron Sutton, Secretary/Treasurer Patti Trefry, Commissioner April Tracy (Virtually), and Commissioner Kimmeron Lisle (Virtually).

2. **Proposed Tax Levy:** Mayor DeNeale reported the proposed millage rate at 2.4979 mills per \$1,000 of Taxable Value.

3. **Review Proposed Budget:** Mayor DeNeale reviewed the Proposed Budget for October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021 as follows:

Ad Valorem Taxes	\$1,878,301
Sewer & Storm	1,416,601
Other Revenues	<u>2,270,310</u>
Total Budget	\$5,565,212

The proposed budget represents a millage rate that is 2.9% above the rollback rate.

4. **Budget Changes:** Mayor DeNeale asked if there were any proposed budget changes. No requests were made.

5. **Public Comments, Commission Response:** There were no public comments.

6. **Resolution 2020-03 to Adopt the Tentative Millage Rate:** Mayor DeNeale read the resolution to adopt the final millage rate of 2.4979 which is greater than the roll back rate of 2.4275 mills by 2.9%.
