He said that continued watering by using the city's small portable water tank would commence.

The Areca hedge at the sewer plant and boat trailer parking commenced on Saturday. Janie's helped with plant choices. Esteban planted green button woods voluntarily.

Janie submitted pictures with by-lines to the Beeline for the December issue. Three pictures were used. In January's Beeline the Mayor and Susan DeNeale helping at the tiki hut garden will be in. Other suggestions are welcome.

Janie made an update presentation to the KCB commission two weeks ago. it was well Accepted.
