Review Resolution No. 2017-04 of the City of Key Colony Beach concerning Chapter 15, Stormwater Utility System, Section 15-4, Schedule of Rates. This is required every year to add the Stormwater assessment to the non-ad valorem portion of the real estate taxes.
