

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for Town of Key Colony Beach's repair of Sunset Park due to damages in Hurricane Irma (DR-4283-FL PW 05993). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 06, 2017 for Hurricane Irma. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

- Proposed Work and Purpose:** The applicant replaced decking and support beams on pier. The applicant will replace pavers and railing for pier; backfill lost sand; replace signage, flagpole, drinking fountain, and fencing; replace wooden deck and shower; and repair palm thatch tiki hut roof. Work will return site to pre-disaster condition.
- Project Alternatives:** The alternative that has been considered is the no action alternative. With the no action alternative, continued negative impacts on residents and the community may be experienced. Action returns site to pre-disaster condition, which facilitates open space usage and a is benefit to the public good. Alternate locations were not considered as the is functionally dependent upon its location within the floodplain.
