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## DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY – DORIAN 2019


**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.38(6)(e), Florida Statutes, gives authority to political subdivisions to declare and enact a State of Local Emergency for a period of up to seven (7) days, thereby waiving the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by law pertaining to:

1. Performance of public work and taking whatever action is necessary to insure the health, safety, and welfare of the community;
2. Enter into contracts;
3. Incurring obligations;
4. Employment of permanent and temporary workers;
5. Utilization of volunteer workers;
6. Rental of equipment;
7. Acquisition and distribution, with or without compensation, of supplies, materials and facilities;
8. Appropriation and expenditure of public funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the threat of high winds, storm surges, heavy rains, flooding and tornadoes associated with Hurricane DORIAN 2019 may require expedient action in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Key Colony Beach City Commission grants the Mayor, or his/her designee authority to declare a State of Local Emergency after consultation with the Emergency Management Director.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, as Mayor of the City of Key Colony Beach, I hereby declare and enact a State of Local Emergency for all of the City of Key Colony Beach, for a period of seven (7) days. Pursuant to this declaration, all procedures and formalities otherwise required of the City of Key Colony Beach and Monroe County, as listed in items 1 through 8 above, are hereby waived. The Emergency Management Director (City Administrator) is hereby ordered to take whatever prudent actions are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community. Emergency Directives signed by the Mayor, Vice Mayor, Mayor's Designee or the Emergency Management Director during the State of Local Emergency have the full force of law in the City of Key Colony Beach.
