Phase 2 recommends continued social distancing, no socializing of groups larger than 50, and bars operate at 50% capacity. Monroe County BOCC will determine if any further restrictions will be put in place locally at the 11:00 meeting today The Department of Health will continue to monitor the situation carefully to determine if restrictions need to be tightened again.
