 <u>Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Roll Call:</u> The public hearing of the Key Colony Beach City Commission was called to order by Mayor Sutton at 5:05 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. *Present:* Mayor Ron Sutton, Vice Mayor Patti Trefry, Secretary/Treasurer Kathryn McCullough, Commissioner Thomas Harding, and Commissioner John DeNeale. *Also Present:* City Administrator David Turner, Utility Clerk Pat Hyland, Executive Assistant Saara Staten, Building Official Gerard Roussin, Public Works Supervisor Michael Guarino, Attorney Ryan Benninger, and Police Chief DiGiovanni. 2. <u>**Proposed Tax Levy:**</u> Mayor Sutton reported the proposed millage rate at 2.8726 mils per \$1,000 Taxable Value.

3. <u>**Review Proposed Budget:**</u> Mayor Sutton reviewed the Proposed Budget for October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022 as follows:

Ad Valorem Taxes	\$4,323,802
Sewer & Storm	1,996,983
Other Funds	851,172
Total Budget	\$7,171,957

The proposed budget represents a millage rate that is 20.45% above the rollback rate.

4. <u>Budget Changes:</u> Mayor Sutton asked if there were any proposed budget changes. No requests were made.

5. <u>Public Comments, Commission Response:</u> There were no public comments. Commissioner McCullough requested that the Staff be compensated generously out of the American Rescue Plan funds. City Administrator Turner agreed.

6. <u>Resolution 2021-10 to Adopt the Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2021-2022</u>: Mayor Sutton read the resolution to adopt the final millage rate of 2.8726 which is greater than the roll back rate by 20.45%.
