

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, on September 9, 2021, adopted Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Tentative Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Key Colony Beach as \$825,568,497.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, that:


1. The Fiscal Year 2021-2022 operating millage rate for the City of Key Colony Beach is 2.8726 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 2.3848 mills by 20.45%.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
