## **Updated COVID-19 Isolation and Quarantine Recommendations**

Day 0 is your first day of symptoms to calculate your isolation period. Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms develop. ## If You Tested Positive for COVID-19

To end isolation after <i>5 days</i> :	<ul> <li>Should not meet any of the criteria in the box below "10 day isolation period for"</li> <li>Symptoms are improving and have been without fever for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.</li> <li>If you are immunocompromised or have moderate to severe illness please consult with your medical provider.</li> <li>Healthcare personnel – follow up with employer for return to work criteria</li> </ul>
To end isolation after <i>10 days:</i>	<ul> <li>Work/attend congregate settings such as: jails, nursing homes (LTCFs/ALFs), and homeless shelters.</li> <li>People with anticipated travel</li> </ul>
