IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN, TURTLE TIME!

April 15th through October 31st (Tax Day through Halloween) is Sea Turtle nesting and hatching season.

We ask that you help protect our endangered Sea Turtles by keeping your beach clear from obstacles that can trap a Sea Turtle, filling in holes dug in the sand, and most importantly, ensuring that all exterior beachfront lighting is compliant with the City's beachfront turtle-lighting recommendations (minimizing artificial lighting disturbance by using long-wavelength light, 560 nanometers or greater; orange, red, or amber LED, and shielded downward-facing fixtures).
