

> Citizen Correspondence

Citizen correspondence addressed to the City Commission will always be shared with the Commission and made part of the record at the next Commission meeting, i.e. "The City Commission received a letter from Mr. John Doe pertaining to proposed changes to building heights". Letters will not be read into the record but are a public record and available to anyone wishing to obtain a copy.

Citizen Comments during Commission Meetings

Citizens may give comments during the specific "Citizen Comments and Correspondence" section on the agenda.

Citizen comments may only pertain to agenda items.

Citizens may speak for three minutes only, once, unless waived by a majority of the Commission.

It is my responsibility as the City Clerk to inform when the time is up. The citizen may ask the Commission for additional time to finish their comments. It is not the City Clerks decision to make.

> Questions answered by the Commission

The Commission does not answer questions during Citizen Comments. Citizen Comments is the opportunity for the Citizen to speak to the Commission in a public setting to have their voices heard. Asking and answering questions would lead to an open-ended discussion, which is not the purpose of a Commission meeting. Commission meetings are for the Commissioners to conduct their business in an organized manner that abides by parliamentary order.
