Below please find a brief update from this Summer's activities in the City of Key Colony Beach.

Marble Hall: Minor roof shingle repairs have been made and new gutters on the fascia were installed. The interior has been freshly painted and trimmed. All meetings and group programs are now meeting in Marble Hall again. We will be finalizing plans for new Police Department, Administration and Building/Code Department offices in City Hall, work will begin in the late fall.

Pickleball/Tennis: New court project has been put out for bids - 2 tennis courts and 6 pickleball courts at the 7th/8th Street park. The job will be awarded in late September.

New City Administrator: Former Marathon Mayor John Bartus has been hired as the Key Colony Beach City Administrator. This is now a part-time position.

New Restaurant: Demo is complete and construction has begun on the new restaurant on the Causeway at the former Sparky's site.

Temporary Building Department Trailer: The Building Department and Code Department have relocated to their former home upstairs in City Hall. The temporary trailer has been removed.

Post Office: The Post Office has been relocated back to its original home next to City Hall. A full makeover on the interior makes it look fresh and bright. The temporary Post Office trailer has been disassembled and removed from the gravel parking lot.

Farmers Market: We are trying to reinstate the Farmers Market in Key Colony Beach this fall – stay tuned for updates.

Lastly, the KBCA is planning for the annual Welcome Back Party to be held Thursday, November 21, 5:00 – 9:00 pm at the Key Colony Inn. Visit kbcba.org for details.
