WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that permitting Commissioners to select their preferred email platforms is in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH. FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Commission hereby approves the use of Commissioners' preferred email addresses and platforms for official communication.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized to take all necessary action to implement designated email addresses and effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
