**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY COLONY BEACH OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, on July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025, adopted Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Tentative Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

**WHEREAS**, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Key Colony Beach as \$1,294,980,149.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Key Colony Beach, of Monroe County, Florida, that:

The Fiscal Year 2025-2026 operating millage rate for the City of Key Colony Beach is 2.82 mills, which is \$2.82 for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value; and is greater than the rolled-back rate of 2.5890 mills by 8.92%.

**This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.**




