

# MINUTES

## Beautification Committee

Tuesday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 – 10:00 am  
Marble Hall, 600 W. Ocean Drive, Key Colony Beach, Florida &  
via Zoom Conferencing.

1. **CALL TO ORDER and ROLLCALL:** The Key Colony Beach Beautification Committee meeting was called to order by Sandy Bachman followed by Rollcall. **Present:** Sandy Bachman, Dave McKeehan, Pam Geronemus. **Also present:** City Administrator John Bartus, Mayor Freddie Foster, Vice-Mayor Doug Colonell, Commissioner Tom DiFransico, Commissioner Kirk Diehl, Administrative Assistant Par Darnall, City Clerk Silvia Roussin. **Guest Attendees:** Nancy Helme, Janie Byland, Janice Mueller, Recreation Chair Cindy Catto.
2. **ELECTION OF CHAIR, VICE-CHAIR, AND SECRETARY-TREASURER** (*Election Procedures: Person(s) is/are nominated; the nomination does not require a second. Votes are cast for each nominee via rollcall*)
  - a. **Election for Chair:** City Clerk Roussin asked for a nomination for Chair.

**NOMINATION:** Pam Geronemus nominated Sandy Bachman for Chair. There were no other nominations.

**ON THE NOMINATION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

Sandy Bachman was reelected Chair of the Beautification Committee.

- b. **Election for Vice-Chair:** Chair Bachman asked for a nomination for Vice-Chair.

**NOMINATION:** Chair Bachman nominated Pam Geronemus for Vice-Chair. There were no other nominations.

**ON THE NOMINATION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

- c. **Election for Secretary-Treasurer:** Chair Bachman asked for a nomination for Secretary-Treasurer.

**NOMINATION:** Vice-Chair Geronemus nominated Dave McKeehan. There were no other nominations.

**ON THE NOMINATION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

### 3. AGENDA ADDITIONS, CHANGES, OR DELETIONS

City Clerk Roussin informed of the following proposed agenda changes.

- Deletion of Item 10b, Jo Corso requested to stay as an Alternate

- Addendum to Agenda Item 10g: Work Party Schedule and Mulch Needs
- Addendum to Agenda Item 10h: Proposed Hot Dogs at the Hut Organizational Roster
- Addendum to Agenda Item 11: Beautification Award Nominee – 180 14<sup>th</sup> Street

There were no other changes, and Chair Bachman asked for a motion to approve the agenda with changes.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Vice-Chair Geronemus to approve the agenda with changes. Chair Bachman seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

4. **INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS:** Guests in attendance introduced themselves to the Committee.

5. **CITIZEN COMMENTS & CORRESPONDENCE:** None.

6. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES - December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025:** There were no changes to the minutes, and Chair Bachman asked for a motion to approve.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Vice-Chair Geronemus to approve. Chair Bachman seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

7. **BUDGET UPDATE**

a. December Budget Report

b. December Giving Tree Report

Dave McKeehan presented his Budget and Giving Tree Report, detailing available funds and expenditures to date.

8. **GARDENING AND LANDSCAPING UPDATES:** Chair Bachman reported a reallocation of responsibilities for gardens in the city and the associated reporting to the Committee.

a. **State of All Gardens**

1. **Orchid Garden & Post Office Tiki:** Guest Attendee Janie Byland asked to report on the Coconut Pathway for future meetings. Janie Byland reported that the Orchid Garden needs some maintenance and offered to take old orchids for donation to transplant. Janie Byland also reported additional maintenance needs, including fern removal, and noted that the Post Office is looking good. The Committee discussed purchasing plants, monthly allowances, the ability to make small purchases up to \$200.00 as needed, and water needs for plantings. Chair Bachman provided additional information on volunteers helping with plantings and watering in the city.

2. **Parking Garden & 7th Street:** Chair Bachman explained the location of the Parking Garden, and Dave McKeehan volunteered to monitor it.

3. **Palm Path & Detention Pond:** Dave McKeehan gave his report on the Detention Pond and his assessment of the vegetation that was planted. Dave McKeehan discussed upcoming needs, including weeding, replanting, and adding mosquito fish to the pond. Mayor Foster stated that Mosquito Control is monitoring the pond and has added mosquito-eating fish. Dave McKeehan further discussed coordination needs with the city and other agencies to ensure the pond's success. Mayor Foster informed that the agreement with the pond was not closed out because of outstanding contractual obligations by the contractor. Mayor Foster advised against any work on the pond until the contractor fulfills all commitments and informed that a meeting with the contractor is scheduled in the next couple of days. The Committee continued discussions on the status of the planted plants and potential future improvements. Mayor Foster advised that the Committee can make improvements to the pond itself without involving plants.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Chair Bachman to approve the allocation of \$1,000.00 for the Detention Pond, in particular towards animal life or other future needs. Dave McKeehan seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

4. **Front & Boulder Garden, 1<sup>st</sup> Street Park:** Vice-Chair Geronemus reported on a dead tree that needs to be removed on 1<sup>st</sup> Street Park, the newly planted trees are growing nicely, and further reported on the picnic table under the tiki that was moved, in addition to a broken bench that needs repairing.
5. **City Hall, Tiki by The Inn, Waterfront Garden, & Sunset Park:** Chair Bachman reported that Mayor Foster would provide future reports on Sunset Park. Chair Bachman noted that the construction fencing is restricting gardening and that the Memorial Garden requires continued watering. Vice-Mayor Colonell explained that the fence would be moved and that the contractor is aware that the garden must be protected. Vice-Mayor Colonell did not anticipate problems with continued watering for transplanted plants. Janie Byland noted the need to replace flowerpots, and the Committee discussed purchasing replacements.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Chair Bachman to allocate \$1000.00 in general funds for purchases for gardening maintenance needs. Vice-Chair Geronemus seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

Mayor Foster offered the help of the Public Works Department to purchase plants on the mainland.

Chair Bachman informed that the Tiki Hut by The Inn needs some pruning.

## **9. BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE IMPROVEMENT LIST**

Chair Bachman reported no new additions to the list and reminded about donated plants for the Orchid Garden. Chair Bachman also reported improvements to the hanging flowerpots on Sadowski Causeway, noting that transplanting has been completed, and outlined mulching and landscaping needs by the Club House. Recreation Committee Chair Catto suggested that the Committee continue beautification of the Golf Course Club House and that the Recreation Committee address safety needs separately. Mayor Foster confirmed that beautification efforts by the Golf Course can continue and that Daryl Rice will oversee mulching needs.

Vice-Mayor Colonell reported on the suggested flowerpot improvements by the bridge and on Public Works Department efforts to build custom flower baskets for the bridge railing. Vice-Mayor Colonell also reported that the project will be completed as soon as possible, time allowing, by the Public Works Department.

Janie Byland commented on rock and dirt seeping into the hedges and interfering with the bike path on the Sadowski Walking/Bike Path and asked for ideas to stop erosion into the mangroves. The Committee discussed the location of the area of concern and agreed to look into possible solutions. Chair Bachman commented that future landscaping needs around the tennis and basketball courts will be deferred until after completion, as will the City Hall Mini Library, which will be deferred until after construction is complete.

**10. COMMITTEE MEMBER ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/APPROVAL**

- a. Discussion/Approval of Appointing Janie Byland to the Beautification Committee:** Chair Bachman expressed her excitement about Janie Byland joining the Committee and asked for a motion to approve.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Chair Bachman to approve Janie Byland as a full-time Committee Member of the Beautification Committee. Vice-Chair Geronemus seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

City Clerk Roussin informed that the recommendation for appointment would come before the City Commission meeting on January 22nd, 2026.

- b. Discussion/Approval of Appointing Janice Mueller to the Beautification Committee as a full-time member:** Chair Bachman asked for a motion to approve.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Vice-Chair Geronemus to approve. Chair Bachman seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

City Clerk Roussin informed the Committee that the recommendation would be presented to the City Commission on January 22nd, 2026, as well.

Additionally, City Clerk Roussin informed the Committee that one open alternate Committee Seat remained, with Nancy Helme expressing interest in applying for the Committee.

- b. ~~Discussion/Approval of Promoting Jo Corso from Alternate to Full-Time Member~~ \*\* deleted**

- c. Discussion/Approval of Replacement of four Dedication Plaques on 4 Park Benches located near the Southwest and West Corners of the Causeway Canal Front:** Chair Bachman spoke about concerns raised by Resident Mary Kohl regarding deteriorating plastic plaques. Mayor Foster commented on his understanding of the intent of the plaque and bench life spans and noted that further discussion would be necessary on the intent of replacements. Discussion followed on how to proceed with deteriorating plaques and benches, and the current plaques no longer deteriorate because they are brass instead of plastic. Mayor Foster further commented on the city's needs for benches and advised the Recreation and Beautification Committee to evaluate them.

- d. Holiday Review:** Chair Bachman reported on a successful holiday decorating season, with help from the Recreation Committee, the Ladies Golf Course league, the Cay Club Condominium, and the Sunset Singers. The Committee further discussed the types of holiday decorations and upgrades, as well as orders for the next year, including decorating the new City Hall Building.

- e. Continued Discussion/Approval on Establishing 'Mini Libraries' throughout the City:** Chair Bachman spoke about ongoing discussions regarding mini-libraries and suggested that the Recreation Committee could assist with the matter. Chair Bachman also reported on research by Sandra Glassman on the matter and noted that further research would be needed to determine needs. The Committee agreed to support the idea of mini-libraries, particularly for children, and asked Vice-Chair Geronemus to follow up on the matter.

- f. **Continued Discussion/Approval for Purchasing a Purple Glory Tree:** Chair Bachman informed that they are waiting to hear from Cristian's Landscaping and to table the topic until the next meeting.
- g. **Continued Review of a Draft Work Party Schedule & Mulch Needs:** Dave McKeehan informed about upcoming work parties, garden and mulching needs, and purchase needs. Dave McKeehan also spoke about gardening and mulching needs before the Hot Dogs in the Hut and Clam Bake event. Chair Bachman informed about the need for more volunteers, and Dave McKeehan hoped to attract volunteers through the Hot Dogs in the Hut event. Discussion continued on upcoming work party schedules and on revisiting additional needs at the next committee meeting.
- h. **Continued Discussion on Organizing the 2026 Hot Dogs in The Hut Event on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026:** Dave McKeehan spoke on the upcoming event and organization of volunteers, including members from the Beautification and Recreation Committee. The Committee discussed the ability to attend and volunteer for the event. Dave McKeehan suggested a coordination meeting on January 24<sup>th</sup> for all volunteers to address questions or potential changes, discussed further needs for specific positions for the event, and proposed providing posters to advertise the event.
- i. **Continued Discussion on Transplanting of City Hall Plants:** Chair Bachman reported on plants and trees that were identified for transplanting from City Hall to other areas of the city, including the golf course and alongside Sadowski Causeway.

**11. DISCUSSION/APPROVAL FOR UPCOMING BEAUTIFICATION AWARDS:**

- a. **Nomination for 180 14<sup>th</sup> Street:** Chair Bachman talked about the January nominee for 180 14<sup>th</sup> Street, and having confirmed with the owners to be present and willing to accept the award.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Vice-Chair Geronemus to approve. Chair Bachman seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

**12. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:** City Clerk Roussin asked if the Committee wanted to make a motion to purchase mulch.

**MOTION:** Motion made by Chair Bachman to order 7 pallets of mulch over the course of the next year. Vice-Chair Geronemus seconded the motion.

**DISCUSSION:** None.

**ON THE MOTION:** Rollcall vote. Unanimous approval.

**13. NEXT MEETING:** Tuesday, February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 3:30 PM.

**14. ADJOURNMENT:** The meeting adjourned at 11:55 AM.
